LIBRARY CARDS

Cedar Springs Public Library cards are issued free of charge to residents that live within the City of Cedar Springs and Solon Township. Temporary library cards may be issued to residents that live within the service area of other Lakeland Library Cooperative libraries. Non-resident cards are available for a nominal fee.

Community members must present their library card to check out materials and place holds.

The replacement fee for a lost, stolen, or damaged card is \$2.00

CIRCULATION

In order to check out materials, community members must present their library cards or Driver's License, and their accounts must be free from fines totaling \$10.00 or more.



DAMAGED ITEMS

DROP BOX

For your convenience, an after-hours drop box is located on the northeast side of the building.

HOLDS

You may place items on hold and be added to the waiting list. Please see staff for assistance. When the item is ready, it can be picked up at your home library.

INTERLOAN

Many items owned by other libraries may be delivered to the library for you to borrow. Please ask at the Desk for additional details and assistance.

RENEWALS

Most items receive 2 automatic renewals.
