

Objective/Goals For Toddler Sensory Station Program:

Sensory bins can support cognitive development as children sort hidden items by size or color. Putting number and letter shapes into the sensory bin can provide children the opportunity to learn the alphabet, their numbers and gain practice with counting and spelling. The sensory stations can build their hand eye coordination, teach them useful everyday tasks, and problem solve.

Objective/Goals For Scavenger Hunt Progressive Program:

The scavenger hunt boosts observation skills and helps children develop early learning skills in a fun, relaxed, and natural way.

Objective/Goals For Unmask a Book Program:

Objective/Goals For I Spy Progressive Program:

The hunt to find hidden objects builds a number of fundamental skills in young children. Babies, toddlers, and preschoolers will enjoy the scavenger hunt for objects hidden in our I spy fish tank. It helps them learn to read, count, and associate words with images or objects. It also helps strengthen their memory and their visual learning skills. They are also learning how to complete a task and a challenge to receive a reward.

Objective/Goals For Mini Artprize Program:

This program teaches teens to foster creativity and imagination. They will have to design, and create a piece of artwork based on a specific theme. Art related books will be on display and shared as inspiration.

Objective/Goals For Tie-Dye Program:

This program teaches kids how to follow and read step-by-step instructions. They will also learn how to make patterns/designs and it fosters creativity and imagination. Craft books for kids will be on display along with Tie-Dye books.

Objective/Goals For Hocus Pocus Program:
